● 30 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Potential Source Of Harm On Premises (8), 250.04(6)(a)1. (8), and Child Record - Enrollment Information (5). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● Child Record - Enrollment Information

250.04(6)(a)1.

Child #1 does not have the required enrollment information on file. The file is missing parent/guardian contact informa

● Child Record - Health History

250.04(6)(a)1m.

Child #1 who is reported to have asthma does not have any Health History information on file at the center.

● Child Record - Immunization History Compliance

250.04(6)(a)4m.

Child #1 does not have documentation of immunizations on file and has been enrolled for more than 30 days.

● Biennial Training - Child Abuse & Neglect

250.05(3)(fm)

Staff A does not have current training in Child Abuse and Neglect. The training on file expired on 8/28/25.

● Potential Source Of Harm On Premises

250.06(2)(e)

There is a mop bucket with water sitting on the floor of the kitchen accessible to children.

● Deteriorating Or Toxic Paint

250.06(2)(k)

There are three areas of flaking/peeling paint. One area is in the living room and two areas in the hallway.

There is no documentation of a fire or tornado drill for September.

There is no documentation that the smoke detectors were tested in September.

An infant was observed sleeping in bouncy seat next to the oven in the kitchen while licensee was cooking.

A child sitting in a high chair for lunch was not strapped in.

The first date of attendance was not documented on the child care enrollment form for child 2.

● **Staff File - Physical Examination - Form**

A physical examination and TB screening was not present or accessible to for staff A.

● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

Nightshade was accessible to children in the outdoor play space and a AC unit did not have a barrier or cover to ensure

● **Toilet Room Door Locks**

250.06(7)(b)2.

The lock for the bathroom door was facing the inside of the bathroom door and was not able to be unlocked from the outsi

● **Infant & Toddler - Use Of Safety Gates**

250.09(1)(c)5.

The safety gate was not secure against the basement stairwell during the monitoring visit.

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
