251.04(2)(L)1.b.

The Department notice of enforcement action was not posted during the monitoring visit.

● **Washrooms - Sanitary Conditions**

251.06(10)(dm)1.

The fan in the bathroom was full of debris and not maintained in a sanitary condition.

● **Outdoor Play Equipment - Construction, Condition**

251.06(11)(bm)3.

A chair, in the outdoor play space was observed with unraveling/loose materials. Areas of the fence had protruding wires

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

There was a pack of opened wipes on a table in the 2 year old classroom. A door labeled tornado shelter, was unlocked,

● **Premises - Well Drained, Clean, In Good Repair**

There was water coming from a hole in the ground, at the entrance of the preschool and school age classrooms.

● **Deteriorating Paint**

There was chipping paint on a changing table and chipping paint at the entrance of the infant classroom.

● **Cleaning Aids - Equipment**

There was a broom, near the handwashing station in the 2 year old classroom, a broom in the preschool classroom and a mo

● **Garbage Containers - Construction & Disposal Schedule**

251.06(2)(n)

The diaper pail in the infant classroom was open and contained soiled diapers.

● **Exits & Passageways - Unobstructed, Minimum Width**

251.06(4)(d)

An exit in the infant classroom was obstructed by toys.

● **Kitchen Equipment & Utensils - Safe & Sanitary**

251.06(9)(a)2.

The refrigerator, in the kitchen, was not maintained in a clean and sanitary condition when there were uncleaned spills

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● **Safe Food**

There was expired infant sweet potatoes baby food and opened expired infant puffs in the kitchen.

● **Food Storage - Refrigeration Units**

The refrigerator in the infant classroom was not maintained at 40 degrees or lower when the refrigerator was at 46 degree

● **Food Storage - Dry Food**

There were open crackers not stored in a bag with a zip-type closure, opened Goldfish crackers, graham crackers and vari

● **Cleanliness Of Furnishings, Toys, Equipment**

There was an infant bouncer chair, in the infant classroom, and a chair in the outdoor space that were unclean.

Cots in the preschool and school age classrooms were not stored in a clean and sanitary manner when cots where uncovered

Documentation of changes in a child's development were not updated every three months in the infant classroom and for a

Opened rice cereal dated 5/29/2025 and open expired Enfamil formula dated 6/11/25 was observed in the infant room.

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

251.06(2)(d)

There was a cabinet that was not locked and had a battery inside that was accessible to children.

● **Premises - Well Drained, Clean, In Good Repair**

251.06(2)(gm)

The bean bag chair was broken and had interior beads on the floor. The sink in the toddler room was not working. Water

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● **Garbage Containers - Construction & Disposal Schedule**

251.06(2)(n)

The garbage can in the school-age room did not have a lid and there was food waste accessible.

● **Safe Food**

251.06(9)(c)1.

There was leftover food in the refrigerator that was not dated. There was infant cereal that was not dated after openin

● **Food Storage - Refrigeration Units**

251.06(9)(d)1.b.

The temperature in the refrigerator located in the infant room was at 54 degrees. There was milk in the refrigerator.

● **Food Storage - Dry Food**

251.06(9)(d)2.a.

There was open veggie straws in the kitchen cabinet that were not sealed in a zip-type container to ensure freshness.

● **Menus - Post**

251.07(5)(a)5.a.

There was no menu posted in the kitchen.

● **Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development**

251.09(1)(c)

The intake under two forms were not updated every three months in the infant room.

● **Infant & Toddler - Bedding**

251.09(1)(k)

The sheets in the infant crib were not tucked tightly under the mattress.

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
