● **Child Record - Immunization History Compliance**

Child #4, 5, and 6 were missing immunization records in their files.

● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

A child on the attendance record on 3/30/26 did not have a last name or birthdate listed.

● **Staff File - Continuing Education**

Staff A and Staff B did not have documentation of continuing education hours for 2025.

● **Provider Training - Current Cpr Certificate**

250.05(3)(e)2.

Staff A did not have a current CPR certificate in their file.

● **Provider Training - Abusive Head Trauma**

250.05(3)(g)

Staff C did not have an Abusive Head Trauma training certificate in their file.

There was a container of baby wipes and a bottle of nail polish remover on the desk in the children s main play room.

There was a kitchen knife in a drying rack and a pair of kitchen scissors on the counter which were accessible to childr

● **Deteriorating Or Toxic Paint**

There were wooden boards in the outdoor play space that had chipping paint.

The back exit was obstructed with a large box, high chair and booster seat.

The noncompliance statement from the visit on April 23, 2025 was not posted.

● **Department Notices Posted**

The Orders letter dated April 25, 2025 was not posted.

● **Child Record - Enrollment Information**

Enrollment information such as persons authorized to call for/receive child and emergency contact information was missin

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● **Child Record - Physical Exam - Under 2**

There was no health report on file for Child #1, who is under the age of two.

● **Current, Accurate Daily Attendance Record**

The attendance record was not accurate at the time of the licensing visit. There were 6 children present but only 5 chil

There was no file available for Staff B.

● **Staff File - Continuing Education**

● **Maximum Number Of Children In Care Of The Provider**

The maximum number of children was exceeded during the time of the licensing visit. There were 4 children under the age

● **Requirements For Additional Provider**

The maximum number of children was exceeded during the time of the licensing visit, and the additional provider on the p

● **Electrical Or Hot Surface Protection**

250.06(2)(a)

Outlets in the children s main play area and in the kitchen behind the children s sitting area were not protected.

● **Access To Materials Potentially Harmful To Children**

250.06(2)(c)

There was a container of disinfecting wipes in the children s main play area and in the kitchen near the children s eati

● **Potential Source Of Harm On Premises**

250.06(2)(e)

There were wooden boards outside that had nails protruding from them. These were accessible to children.

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● **Premises - Condition & Repair**

250.06(2)(m)

The premise was not maintained in a sanitary condition at the time of the licensing visit. There was garbage throughout

● **Exits - Unobstructed**

250.06(7)(a)1.

The secondary exit (back exit) was obstructed with cots, boxes and other items.

● **Safe Food**

250.06(9)(c)

There were expired cartons of milk in the refrigerator.

● **Infant & Toddler - Crib & Playpen Mattresses**

250.09(1)(c)2.

Mattress coverings were not tight-fitting at the time of the licensing visit.

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
