Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 251.06(2)(i) (12), Medication Administration - Containers & Labeling (6), and Deteriorating Paint (5). None of the 30 findings were critical.

● **Deteriorating Paint**

There is flaking paint on the wall in the infant room where the adult rocking chair has been hitting it.

● **Manual Dishwashing - 3-Step Procedure**

Dishes and bottles washed in the infant room were not washed using the three step procedure.

● **Medication Administration - Containers & Labeling**

251.07(6)(f)1.b.

Two diaper creams for specific children were not labeled with a name.

● **Infant & Toddler - Documenting Changes In Development**

Two infant and toddler intake forms have not been updated in the last 3 months. One was last updated on 5/15/25 and one

● **Infant & Toddler - Food & Formula Brought From Home**

251.09(3)(a)2.

Two containers of formula are not labeled with a child s name or dated.

● **Infant & Toddler - Leftover Milk Or Formula**

251.09(3)(a)7.

Several bottles of left over milk were not rinsed after use.
