If the caregiver or a household member has convictions of those listed in paragraph 6.4.b. of this subdivision, a family child care provider shall not operate or continue operations unless the caregiver requests a waiver or variance and it is approved by the Secretary.

● **Achieved**

Keep documentation available on site of rabies vaccinations for all cats and dogs kept on the premises

● **Achieved**

Only use cribs and portable pack and play yards that comply with the Consumer Product Safety Commission standards, Cribs manufactured after June 28, 2011, and any portable pack and play yards manufactured after February 19, 2014

● **Achieved**

The caregiver shall obtain a medical examination and either a tuberculosis risk assessment, a TB skin test, or chest x-ray within 30 days of application for a certificate of registration and upon application for renewal of the certificate of registration.

● **Achieved**

Thereafter, the caregiver shall complete eight hours of approved training annually, encompassing a minimum of two Core Knowledge/Core Competency areas.
