● **Achieved**

A family child care home shall maintain all completed parental forms required by the Department, including emergency information and medical forms, on file.

● **Achieved**

Caregivers completing approved training resulting in certification in basic first aid and rescue breathing shall renew the certification thirty days prior to the date the certification in such training expires.

● **Achieved**

Emergency consent forms shall be notarized.

● **Achieved**

Emergency information for each child and parental permission forms for emergency medical treatment shall be obtained prior to a child's placement in the home, maintained in the providers records, and updated when information changes.

● **Achieved**

The Secretary shall not grant a certificate of registration to a family child care home if the caregiver or a household member is an active recipient of child or adult protective services or has a history of substantiated child or adult abuse or neglect as determined by a court of law or an investig
