A general medical examination for all children shall be obtained by the parents within thirty (30) days of admission to the home, provided the examination was completed no more than six (6) months prior to the child's admission to the home

● **Achieved**

Children's medical examination records shall be updated every two years until the child is six years of age

● **Achieved**

Immunization records shall be completed and updated according to the schedule recommended by the Department

● **Achieved**

Medical examinations completed up to six months prior to application or renewal are acceptable.

● **Achieved**

The caregiver shall obtain a medical examination and either a tuberculosis risk assessment, a TB skin test, or chest x-ray within 30 days of application for a certificate of registration and upon application for renewal of the certificate of registration.
