Examination forms shall indicate that the caregiver has no physical or mental condition that would negatively impact the provision of child care services. The results of the tuberculosis screening must be negative.

The caregiver shall obtain a medical examination and either a tuberculosis risk assessment, a TB skin test, or chest x-ray within 30 days of application for a certificate of registration and upon application for renewal of the certificate of registration.

● **Achieved**

The family child care home shall maintain a record of current medical examinations which includes the tuberculosis risk assessment, TB skin test or chest-x-ray results completed within 30 days of the original application.
