Equipped with band aids, a non-mercury thermometer, gauze, tape scissors, tweezers, disposable nonporous gloves, a first aid guide, the telephone number of a poison control center, and pencil and paper. A bottle of clean water shall be stored with or accompany the first aid kit; and

● **Achieved**

Readily available at all times, including in the outdoor activity area, on all trips away from the center and in each vehicle provided by the center for the transportation of children.

● **Achieved**

Staff-to-child ratio and group size are always maintained based on the age of the youngest child in the group.
