If the caregiver or a staff member or household member failed to report convictions to the Department, a family child care home shall not operate or continue operations unless the caregiver requests a waiver or variance and it is approved by the Secretary.

● **Achieved**

Submit fingerprints for purposes of obtaining a state and federal criminal history background check. Fingerprinting must be done initially and repeated at the expiration of rap back enrollment.
