● **Achieved**

A center shall secure from the employee a recent health assessment performed not more than 90 days prior to the date hired for the employee and signed by a licensed health care provider. The health assessment shall be on file no later than 30 days from the first date of employment. A health assess

● **Achieved**

A physical examination, including vision and hearing screening

● **Achieved**

A significant health history which the center needs to know in order to protect the health of the employee or the health and safety of children in care

● **Achieved**

A statement that the prospective staff member has no known condition or disease which would interfere with the proper care of children; and

● **Cited rule**

Equipped with band aids, a non-mercury thermometer, gauze, tape, scissors, tweezers, disposable nonporous gloves, a first aid guide, the telephone number of a poison control center, and pencil and paper. A bottle of clean water shall be stored with or accompany the first aid kit; and
